Their graduation will be Sunday Sept. 29 at 5:00 at Bethesda. ***This is open to anyone interested in encouraging these 4 from our community to celebrate this first step for them.***

The next step in this process involves pairing the individual or couple with one or two others who will become “allies” for them. The “allies” will walk alongside their individual or couple in the next learning and application phase of overcoming the poverty lifestyle. Mark Rogers will be teaching the Allie training Classes during the month of Oct. at Bethesda.
